The goal of the Good Neighbor Award is to recognize our REALTORS® for their efforts in community and charitable service in helping to make their communities a better place for all citizens. They must focus on ONE Charity in their entry. This is the organization that will receive the cash contribution.

CRITERIA FOR GOOD NEIGHBOR

- Must be a REALTOR® member in good standing*
- Must be a primary member of the Local Association*
- Service must be a non-business endeavor*
- Award recipient may win only once in a lifetime*
- Services shall be recognized not for financial contributions but for service contributions.*
- Award recipient shall not be a full-time employee of the charity or be compensated for any work or service.*
- Some portion of the nominee's community work must have taken place during the previous year.*
