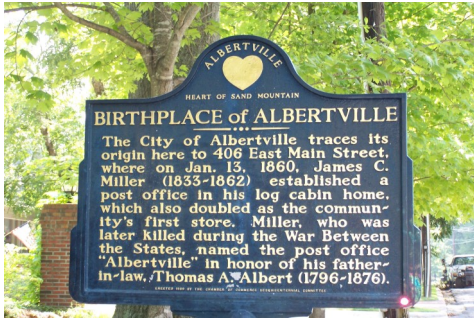

Historical Site of Albertville

Pre-Civil War Cemetery

A great place to begin studying the history of Albertville is the city's West Main Street Cemetery, where most of Albertville's prominent early settlers are buried. One such citizen was Thomas A. Albert, one of the first men to live on Sand Mountain. Born in Georgia in 1776, he fought in the War of 1812. Later, after he married, he moved into

Marshall County to settle the area

that would later be named in his honor. He lived in Albertville until his death in 1876. Albertville's first Mayor and State Representative, William M. Coleman, is also buried here. He is noteworthy for his work in the passage of the Agricultural School Bill.

The West Main Street Cemetery began in the late 1850's. Many of the monument's names and dates are barely legible due to the effects of time and the elements. But two stones seemingly unweathered are the markers of T.J. Hamlin, 1825-1881, and Mary Hamlin, 1831-1873. On these tombstones, both made from an old rock, the inscriptions were carved using a hammer and chisel. They have been standing side-by-side for over a hundred years.

Other notable Albertville settlers buried in the West Main Street Cemetery are S.M. Elrod, one of the first physicians located on Sand Mountain; W.M. Scarbrough, one of the early Baptist preachers in the area; federal Judge L. Edward Creel Jr.; Joseph Kellet, a sergeant in the Civil War; L.S. Emmett, a Civil War veteran and one of Albertville's graves of soldiers who fought in the Civil War.

It is unclear just how many of the graves are simply marked by a brick or fieldstone, half hidden by the overgrown grass. As the first highway cut through the area, road crews laid the road to curve around the cemetery. People in town didn't want the graveyard to be disturbed, and the highway workers honored their wishes.

Albertville Regional Airport

ABOUT US

The **Albertville Regional Airport** contributes greatly to the economic development and stability of northeast Alabama. The airport is home to the [Alabama Aviation College](#), BAE Systems, RainAir Aviation and Mid-South Aviation along with six corporate hangers and thirty-six T-hangers with additional construction imminent. The airport averages approximately 4,000 operations per year with 80% of those operations being corporate in nature. In addition, a 20 acre Technology Park adjacent to the airport is under development.

Thomas J. Brumlik Field offers many amenities. With a runway of 6,117 ft. long, 100 ft. wide and RNAV Instrument Approach Procedures, Albertville Regional Airport can accommodate business and private jets. The runway lighting system consists of Pilot Control Lighting, Runway End Identifier (REIL) Lights and Precision Approach Path Indicator (PAPI) Lights. The airport also has an Automated Weather Observing System (AWOS), giving pilots the sky conditions, visibility, barometric pressure, wind conditions and density altitude of the airfield. Common traffic approach frequency is 123.0.

The airport houses approximately 60 aircrafts in hanger space, and has tie down space for 40 aircraft. A terminal facility and airport staff provides pilots, passengers, and visitors with accommodations to relax during layovers and refueling. The facility has Wi-Fi connection, a pilot's lounge, conference room, and vending area. Additional features of the Albertville Regional Airport include a fueling system with 100 LL Aviation Gas and Jet-A fuel and perimeter fencing for security and runway safety.

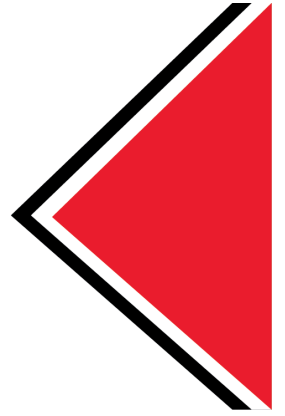
