

Sutherlin Reboot: 2020 Community Cash Guidelines and Agreement

The following outlines the program specifics:

- Community Cash is in \$10.00 denominations.
- Drawn from a closely monitored special Chamber Account.
- Contains security features for the Chamber's and Participants safety.
- The following is printed on the checks: "Must use by October 31st, 2020".
- Certificates are made payable to the following "Redeemable at participating Sutherlin Area Chamber of Commerce businesses".
- Be sure to decide on your policy for partial redemptions. If a customer spends less than the Certificate value, you can offer cash back, store credit, or issue a store gift certificate for the balance. It is up to you.
- A Chamber Community Cash Participation List, including the business names of all program participants, will be printed on the back of each bill. The list is subject to change at any time and this fact is stated on the list.
- A program enrollment form must be on file for each participating business.
- The Chamber will distribute up to 1,000 certificates in the \$10 denomination.
- You may participate in the Community Cash Program if you are a chamber member in good standing and current on your membership dues. As a participant, you have the right to refuse any Chamber Gift Check that appears altered, copied, or that is questionable. Program terms, conditions, and benefits are subject to change. The Chamber does not guaranty the increase of sales or customers by participation.
- The Chamber is providing this service as a benefit for its members. The Chamber shall not be responsible for any incidental, consequential, or other damages resulting from the program.
