Manatee Boat Tours: Local boat captains through the Manatee Eco Tourism Association will offer boat tours on a first-come first-serve basis. Tickets are available for \$10 for adults; \$5 for children 6 – 12 years old; and children 5 and under free. The tickets are good only on the date purchased and are sold at the boat

dock area near northwest Third Street (Kings Bay Park).

Guided Kayak Tours: \$10 guided kayak tours will be offered at the festival through Hunter Springs Kayaks. Tour guides will take you on a 1-hour tour of the bay and Hunter Springs area giving a first-hand glance at the beauty of our Nature Coast! You can book your time in advance online through the link

Rehire Furloughed Employee Grant Program for businesses

GARDENS OPEN

The BOCC recently allocated \$300,000 to the Citrus County Chamber of Commerce for a grant program for businesses that furloughed employees due to COVID-19 and have since rehired them. To qualify, the business must have furloughed an employee for a minimum of two months before rehiring and steadily employing for a minimum of 90 days. The grant amount is \$2,000 per rehired full-time equivalent employee.
