We take pride in awarding \$1,000 scholarships to two graduating seniors, one male and one female. To be eligible, students must be graduating in the academic year 2021-2022. The applicant must reside in Manteno and have at least a 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale. The scholarship criteria are based on the applicant's scholastic achievement, interest in continuing education and career goals, participation and leadership in school and community activities, and reputation for good citizenship and moral character.

Enclosed with this letter is the application packet with the list of requirements. Applications will be evaluated by the Chamber Scholarship Committee, and scholarships will be announced by May 9, 2022.

- a. Applicants must submit (1) letter of recommendation (from counselor, principal, teacher, employer, clergy, mentor, coach) appraising the individual's academic & personal qualities & potential. The Scholarship Committee is particularly interested in evidence of character, relative maturity, integrity, independence, interests, skills, and any special talents or qualities.

Information & Tips for Scholarship Applicants

1. DO NOT WAIT TO APPLY
2. The student must be a graduating senior of the 2021-2022 academic school year.
3. Applicants must have a grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
4. The scholarship recipients will be selected by the Chamber Scholarship Foundation Committee.
5. The scholarship must be used for expenses with the requirement that recipient be a full-time student.
6. All requirement documents must be postmarked by April 11, 2022. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that documents are submitted to the Chamber and are postmarked on or before April 11, 2022 (such as letter of recommendation or transcripts if submitted separately).
7. Each component of the application will be considered in the evaluation. Incomplete applications will not be considered. There shall be no discrimination based on race, color, creed, religion, sexual orientation, or gender.
8. Scholarship Recipients will be notified by May 9, 2022, through email and a personal letter. Awards will be presented on May 19th at the Chamber's Celebration of Membership Dinner.
9. Awarded scholarships will be in the amount of \$1,000 each to one male & one female recipient.
