	NCUS has the lowest and best proposed fee along with the projected participation rates that exceed the SCMWDP GJC obligation											
	Stark State's proposed # of candidates to upskill does not meet SCMWDP GJC metric. Stark State's upskilling program can be folded into a co-branded promotion of TechCred. State TechCred funds can pay for upskilling through interested employers. SCMWDP can coordinate promotion of TechCred and Stark State classes.											
	Ican housing works with homeless and transitional housing individuals and families including minorities, single women and veterans. Their per candidate fee is higher and their metrics do not meet the SCMWDP GJC obligations.

	Contract with NCUS for 1 year, renewable yearly for total of 3 years											
	Approach Stark State and develop a program promoting their credentialing to employers and assist employers in applying for TechCred											
	Approach Ican to see if a smaller 1 year contract can be negotiated to tap into recruiting,training for the veteran population. OMA may have suppleme,tnal funds noted below
