Welcome to Long Prairie

Nestled in the valley of the Long Prairie River, the city of Long Prairie is a postcard-perfect place brimming with both historical charm and modern appeal. Church steeples and the historic Todd County Courthouse punctuate the landscape along with beautiful old trees and the river itself.

Established in 1845, the community served as an Indian Agency and boasted a population greater than what it is today. In the intervening years, Long Prairie was a stop along the railroad with the Reichert Hotel acting as both a spot of culture and a place to rest weary bones. A farming culture grew up and Main Street supplied food, clothing, supplies, and materials for that economy for the better part of a century.

As time went on, Long Prairie grew to include more forms of business. An industrial sector began with a printing company that employed hundreds before the decline in print media caused it to lose traction, giving way to the meat packing industry. This evolution attracted a workforce that brought with it a diverse ethnic experience, enhancing the local urban environment and bringing the world to our doors. The rich land also attracted a large Amish population that added buggies, greenhouses, fresh farm produce, and craftsmanship to the local landscape and economy.

Today, Long Prairie reflects on its past by offering historical views via the Todd County Museum, the Victorian Christie House, Riverside Park built by the WPA (Works Progress Administration), and several memorial sites.

It celebrates the present by offering an 18-hole golf course; one of the last drive-in theatres; diversity in restaurants and shops; river, lake, and park recreational opportunities; a Summer in the Park concert series; chamber orchestra concerts; festivals, fairs, and fun.

To acknowledge past, present, and future, Long Prairie hosts several schools; the court, legal, and veterans' system for Todd County; and many organizations for individual, family, and general community enrichment.



Long Prairie looks to the future with awareness of computer and technological needs. Roads, bridges, and general infrastructure improvements are ongoing.



Located in the same building that houses the Great River Regional Library and the Long Prairie Chamber of Commerce, the WAVE/Saludos Center welcomes newcomers to the area and offers information to help them settle in.

The name Welcoming Advocates Valuing Everyone, or WAVE, was chosen to represent the greeting and reception newcomers will experience from this helpful enterprise. Saludos is the Spanish translation for "wave."

- organizing support groups to provide advocacy and information about resources and opportunities
- consulting and connecting with community partners to be just, equitable, diverse, and inclusive
- providing orientation and education around areas that may be different from newcomers' places of origin
- developing a protocol for handling immigration issues, prioritizing emergency needs, and assisting with paperwork for citizenship, renewal of Green Cards.

Faster than Broadband

High-speed fiber Internet is available in Long Prairie and is provided through Consolidated Telecommunication Company (CTC). Connections with speeds up to one Gig improve bandwidth and reliability. Fiber Internet offers:

- opportunities for online trainings, and e-learning
- growth of home-based businesses
- access to tele-health
- telecommuting for employees.

Fiber Internet is currently available within the city limits. Todd County is seeking state and federal funding for expansion into the surrounding area.

Todd Field Airport

At an elevation of 1,333 feet, Todd Field has one runway designated 16/34 with a 3,000- by 75-foot asphalt runway. A small lounge and bathroom is in the newly refurbished Arrival/Departure building.



Long Prairie-Grey Eagle Public Schools

Long Prairie's public school system begins with Head Start and Early Childhood Family Education. These, along with Pre-K through grade six, hold classes in the 2nd Street South location, not far from downtown. The Secondary grades (7-12), which include students from the Grey Eagle consolidation, meet on the northeast side of town in the 9th Street building complex. The student body totals about 950. Students in the upper grades are fortunate to be able to take college-level classes and may complete a two-year college degree while in high school. Adult Basic Education Classes

Adult Basic Education (ABE) Classes offer basic skills development in reading, writing, math, digital literacy (computer skills), English language, and more. ABE Classes require no tuition (although some courses may require materials fees and/or GED test fees) and provide for flexible scheduling, individualized curricula, online/hybrid learning options, and self-paced learning.

Classes are held weekly in Long Prairie, Little Falls, Staples, and Wadena. Classes in Long Prairie are located at the Long Prairie-Grey Eagle Elementary school building.

Historical Activities

Museums bookend Central Avenue

The Christie House, built in 1901, presents a window into the life and work of a locally prominent doctor and his family. The house lies on the west end of Main Street and is a beautiful example of life in the early 20th century. christiehome.org | 320.732.2514

The Todd County Museum, on the east end, offers an expansive look into the history of the entire county. The facade features murals by artist Nancy Packard Leasman and displays scenes from pre-settlement to modern times. toddcountymuseum.com | 320.732.4426

Between the bookends lie **Veterans Memorial Park** and its huge mural of the Battle of Iwo Jima, as well as shops and restaurants. Stop in at the **post office** and take a look at the fresco "Gathering Rice" by WPA artist Lucia Wiley.

Historic Todd County Courthouse

The Historic Todd County Courthouse is a dominant feature of the landscape overlooking Long Prairie. Built on a hill in 1883, the building required over 100 tons of stone for



the foundation and 400,000 bricks for the structure. In 2010, a project was undertaken to renovate the courthouse to preserve its historical features and observe modern accessibility requirements. An addition to the original structure concentrated the county sheriff's facility, government offices, and social services for easy access. Visitors are welcome during regular business hours.

Long Prairie River

A State Water Trail, the Long Prairie River originates 26 miles west of town, at Lake Carlos and flows east and north for 96 miles, finally feeding into the Crow Wing River. Along the way it offers infinite opportunities for canoing, kayaking, tubing, fishing, and shooting sports.

Lake Charlotte Park

Situated on the edge of town is Lake Charlotte, a local natural treasure that provides a wealth of outdoor activities both on and off the water. The lake is 144 acres in size and 84 feet at its deepest, making it ideal for swimming, boating of all kinds, and fishing. A public access and fenced fishing pier make enjoying the lake a breeze.

Covering a sizable stretch of the lake's northeast shore is Lake Charlotte Park, a combined project of the city and the local Lion's Club. The park offers a swimming beach with a bathhouse featuring a colorful mosaic and mural, as well as a host of other amenities: playground equipment, a picnic shelter, sand volleyball courts, a softball field, a fenced-in basketball court, a 12-hole Frisbee golf course, and public restrooms. Together with the natural beauty of the lake, the offerings at Lake Charlotte Park make it a delightful place to spend summer days.


navigate to cleverly hidden containers called geocaches. It offers something for everyone, from families with children to retirees.

Art in Nature

Long Prairie is a city that values the arts, including public art that can be enjoyed on a stroll. One excellent example is the Blue Sky Project, led by artist Claire Witt, which involved Long Prairie community members of all ages. The creation of the mosaic planters in Harmony Park, as well as the one on the beach house at Lake Charlotte Park, express Witt's concept of "blue sky" which in business refers to the goodwill a proprietor has gained over years of fair action. The mosaics also create an immediate visual of tranquility and universal connection. The full title of this project is "'La Familia de la Blue Sky,' a phrase combining both English and Spanish, one human family under the blue sky."

Digitized to embrace 21st-century technology, the Long Drive-in will continue to offer feature films, concessions, and special events for years to come.













Visit Amish and Mennonite Businesses

The Amish live a simple life with a reluctance to adopt modern conveniences. Horses and buggies are their primary transportation; their clothing is plain. They value rural life, manual labor, humility, and adherence to their Christian doctrine. Mennonites maintain some of these traditional

lifestyle components but do not refrain from using motor vehicles. Their clothing, while modest, includes more color.

The Amish run a number of businesses in Todd County. Offerings in the Long Prairie area include saddle repair, bridles, dog collars, leashes, hardwood flooring, cedar and oak chests, picnic tables, lawn furniture, decking, pallet components, lumber cut to order, log structures, metal roofing, trim, nails, screws, closure strips, handmade baskets, and various craft items. It's common to find Amish vendors offering roadside service with quilts, baked and canned goods, and other items. Amish greenhouses offer a huge assortment of spring planting options. Two former Amish families offer caskets, urns, fish houses, boat covers, and tarps. Amish and Mennonite stores are sprinkled throughout the county. They specialize in baking and cooking products, kitchen tools, and books, among other items.




