Committees

- <u>Public Policy:</u> The Public Policy Committee monitors and advises the Chamber on legislative and regulatory issues on the City, County, and State levels and promotes the interests of our membership. Meets the 2nd Tuesday of the month at 2:00 pm.
- <u>Membership</u>: The Membership Committee serves as Ambassador for the Chamber in our community and supports our local businesses with a focus on member recruitment and retention. The committee strives to enhance the new member experience to ensure members are maximizing the use of their membership.

The Committee:

- Provides an ambassador for each new member.
