## Invitation to Become a Testing Location

The SFFMA Industrial Firefighter certification has now been developed, and the association is looking for member industrial facilities that would be interested in hosting written examinations for the certification. SFFMA will provide examinees with all testing materials; what we need are facilities that meet the following requirements:

### THE LOCATION MUST:

- Have adequate internet capability to allow up to 15 individuals to take an exam via an online format.
- Provide an environment that is clean, comfortable, smoke free, and conducive to testing. The testing room should be in a low-traffic area so that noises and other distractions can be minimized.
- Allow for a classroom-style setup with all seating facing the same direction.

### ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES FOR CURRENT COVID-19 CONDITIONS:

- The testing room must allow for at least six (6) feet of separation between each examinee.
- Testing personnel will require that each examinee wear a face mask while present in the testing room, and strictly control persons entering and exiting the room.
- Testing personnel will also conduct disinfecting procedures of surfaces before and after each testing session.
