

Quick Reference for SFFMA Industrial Firefighter Program

SFFMA is offering two Industrial Firefighter certifications: Industrial Firefighter I and Industrial Firefighter II.

Industrial Firefighter I consists of these components or required prerequisites:

- CPR, AED, and First Aid certification
- ICS-100, ICS-200, and NIMS 700 certification
- Hazardous Materials Technician certification (NFPA 472/1072)
- Advanced Exterior Industrial Fire Brigade Member (NFPA 1081)

Industrial Firefighter II consists of the above components, plus the following additional requirement:

- Interior Structural Industrial Fire Brigade Member (NFPA 1081)

THE INDIVIDUAL

What must the individual do to obtain Industrial Firefighter I?

- Complete the following training:
 - CPR, AED, and First Aid
 - ICS-100, ICS-200, and NIMS 700
 - Hazardous Materials Technician in accordance with NFPA 472/1072
 - Advanced Exterior Industrial Fire Brigade Member training in accordance with NFPA 1081 (including skills)
- Submit proof of completed training (certificates, etc.) to your facility Training Coordinator.
- Take and pass the SFFMA exam for Advanced Exterior Industrial Fire Brigade Member if needed. An individual who submits a ProBoard or IFSAC certificate for this discipline will not be required to take the SFFMA exam.
- NOTE: Scheduling of an exam, if needed, will be handled by your facility Training Coordinator in cooperation with SFFMA staff.

What must the individual do to obtain Industrial Firefighter II?

- Hold SFFMA Industrial Firefighter I certification, or complete the above training required for Industrial Firefighter I.
- In addition, complete training for Interior Structural Industrial Fire Brigade Member in accordance with NFPA 1081 (including skills).
- Submit proof of completed training (certificates, etc.) to your facility Training Coordinator.
- NOTE: An individual who already holds SFFMA Industrial Firefighter I certification need only complete the additional training and submit that documentation to their facility Training Coordinator.
- Take and pass the SFFMA exam(s) if needed. An individual who submits ProBoard or IFSAC certificate(s) for the necessary discipline(s) will not be required to take the SFFMA exam.
 - If you already hold SFFMA Industrial Firefighter I: Take and pass the exam for Interior Structural Industrial Fire Brigade Member (if no ProBoard or IFSAC).
 - If you do not already hold SFFMA Industrial Firefighter I: Take and pass the exams for Advanced Exterior Industrial Fire Brigade Member, and Interior Structural Industrial Fire Brigade Member (if no ProBoard or IFSAC).
- NOTE: Scheduling of an exam, if needed, will be handled by your facility Training Coordinator in cooperation with SFFMA staff.

THE INDUSTRIAL FACILITY

What should the facility Training Coordinator do?

- Compile the above proof of training/certifications for each facility member pursuing an SFFMA Industrial Firefighter certification.
- When ready, submit to SFFMA for each facility member:
 - Application for the desired SFFMA certification
 - Proof of training/certificates
 - Required fee
- SFFMA staff will coordinate with you regarding testing for those facility members who must take the SFFMA Industrial Firefighter exam(s). (see important note below)

****IMPORTANT NOTE:**

Facility personnel who completed training for Advanced Exterior and/or Interior Structural Fire Brigade Member, and have **ProBoard or IFSAC certificates** for those will not be required to take the SFFMA exam. An SFFMA certification for the applicable level of Industrial Firefighter will be issued following receipt and acceptance of the application, verification of all required training, and the fee.
