## **ARTICLE VI - Delegates**

*Section 1.* Each regularly organized fire department<u>of the 16 Districts</u> shall be entitled to five<u>twenty (20)</u> delegates at the Annual Training Conference and Convention, provided that all sections to the by-laws have been complied with.

*Section 2.* All delegates must be current individual dues paying members, except Industrial members. Industrial Members must be from a participating Industrial Organization to be delegates and each participating Industrial Organization can have up to five voting delegates. No member delegate shall be allowed to be represented by proxy. Delegates will be appointed by their districts. A list of delegates from each of the districts shall be furnished to the Secretary prior to the opening of the first business session at the Annual Training Conference and Convention.

*Section* 3. Lists of delegates from each member department or organization shall be furnished to the secretary upon registration at the Annual Training Conference and Convention.<u>All</u> delegates must be current individual dues paying members, unless otherwise exempted from individual dues in accordance with the bylaws.

*Section* 4. Each regularly organized district, county, fire service organization and rescueassociation, and Fire Marshals' Office as recognized by the Executive Board shall be eligible forone delegate to the Annual Training Conference and Convention upon payment of the properannual dues to this Association.<u>All member organizations</u>, including those that are industrial organizations, Active Members and Organization Members are encouraged to participate in their respective districts and offer individuals to be appointed and selected as delegates.
