1081: Industrial Firefighter Certifications

Step 1: Verify industrial facility is current on SFFMA membership (application form)

Step 2: Facility reports names of ERT Head and Training Coordinator. One person can fill both roles and is not required to have individual SFFMA membership for these purposes.

Step 3: Verify applicant is current on SFFMA membership. If not, individual dues will be charged at the time of application submission.

Step 4: Verify applicant can provide course completion documents for each of the following:

Industrial Firefighter I

- CPR, AED, and First Aid training
- ICS-100, ICS-200, and IS-700 as defined by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).
- Hazardous Materials Technician certification in accordance with:
 - i. NFPA 472/1072; or
 - ii. OSHA 29CFR1910.120 (q); or
 - iii. proof of equivalent training in this discipline.
- Advanced Exterior Industrial Fire Brigade Member coursework meeting the requirements of NFPA 1081 or proof of equivalent training in this discipline, including successful demonstration of required skills.

Industrial Firefighter II (in addition to each of the above)

- Interior Structural Industrial Fire Brigade Member coursework meeting the requirements of NFPA 1081, or proof of equivalent training in the discipline, including successful demonstration of required skills.

Step 5: Fully complete an [Industrial Firefighter application form](#) and submit along with the documents listed above.

Step 6: Austin staff assess a one-time \$25 application processing fee per level per person. Fees payable by remitting payment with invoice or via telephone. Payments received without invoices may delay processing.

Step 7: Austin staff issues an Endorsement of Eligibility to challenge the applicable written exam.

Holder of IFSAC or ProBoard certificate(s) for Advanced Exterior or Internal Structural Industrial Fire Brigade qualify for SFFMA Industrial Firefighter certification with no test required.

Step 8: Austin office will schedule exam sessions by request through a participating facility or at Austin Office. Contact SFFMA Industrial Coordinator at industrial@sffma.org to schedule.
