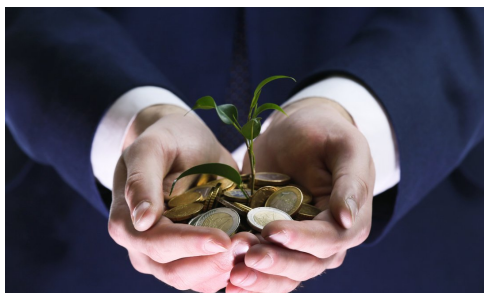

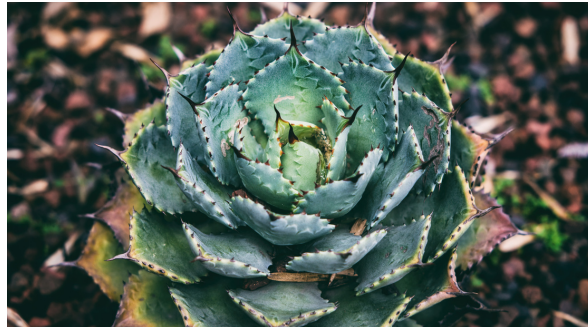

We are once again coordinating the "Santa Cop" program and are asking for your help! Lafayette is a unique community that includes a wide range of incomes. Many people do not realize there are still many Lafayette families that struggle to provide basic life necessities. For some parents, providing holiday gifts for their children is next to impossible.

The Lafayette Police Department hosts the Santa Cop Program every year. This program coordinates gift donations for families in need in our community. This program helps provide a little brighter holiday for some local families.

If you would like to help support this program, we appreciate new toy donations (appropriate for ages 2-15), or if you prefer, please consider making a monetary donation (to the Lafayette Police Department) to help us continue this much needed program. We cannot always meet the needs of our nominated families by donated toys. We use monetary donations to purchase additional specific gifts that meet other needs. We accept donations year-round, but toy collection boxes are placed in many City facilities in November.

You may drop off a monetary donation (cash, check or credit card) to the Lafayette Police Department during normal business hours (Monday-Friday, 8am-5pm). If you wish to mail a donation, our address is 451 North 111th Street. Monetary donations can also be accepted from the finance department at Lafayette City Hall during normal business hours, 1290 S. Public Road.

If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me! Donations for the 2021 program need to be received by December 6. Donations received after December 6 will go toward next year's program. Thank you very much if you can help support this program!
