

#### **National Prescription Drug Take Back Day**

The Lafayette Police Department participates in the National Prescription Drug Take Back Day events each year. This day focuses on removing potentially dangerous controlled substances from our medicine cabinets. A National Drug Take Back Day provides the public an opportunity to surrender expired, unwanted, or unused pharmaceutical controlled substances and other medications to law enforcement officers for destruction.

Items that cannot be accepted for take back programs are needles, mercury thermometers, oxygen containers, chemotherapy or radioactive substances, pressurized canisters, and illicit drugs. Find more about what items are accepted at lafayetteco.gov/PrescriptionDrugTakeBack.

Dr. Nowak received his undergraduate and master's degrees in Human Physiology from Eastern Michigan University, and earned his combined degree of Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine and PhD in Human and Molecular Physiology at the Medical Scientist Training Program, as well as an internship/residency in Internal Medicine and fellowship in General/Invasive Cardiology at Michigan State University. He also obtained sub-specialty training in Interventional Cardiology at Loyola University Medical Center.

Dr. Nowak is also board certified in Endovascular Medicine and has special interest in treating patients with peripheral artery disease (PAD).
