- Any additional award letters for scholarships you have received.

# VII. Recipient selection

The CVBIA Scholarship Selection Committee reviews all applications in April and selects recipients based on the following criteria:

- Academic performance throughout high school
- School-affiliated activities
- Community involvement
- Written description of financial need (section IV)

Students chosen to receive a scholarship will receive an **award acceptance form by May 5, 2023 that must be completed and returned within seven days of notification.** The award acceptance form requests that the recipient accept or decline the scholarship. If the student accepts the scholarship, he/she/them must provide a copy of the financial aid award letter from their selected college/university and a list of all private scholarships received.

**CVBIA sends scholarship money directly to the college/university each semester.** No money is sent to the students. Recipients are not allowed to receive financial aid in excess of their school's budgeted cost of attendance. In order for CVBIA to send the semester payments, it must receive an official transcript from the recipient's college/university, along with a form, provided by CVBIA, requesting to continue the scholarship. **Recipients must maintain at least a 2.0 GPA.** 

CVBIA scholarship recipients must attend an accredited four-year college/university as a full-time student. **The four-year period of study must be continual and uninterrupted (not including summer semesters).** Recipients can also choose to begin their degree program as full-time students at an accredited two-year institution and transfer to a four-year institution in their third year.
