

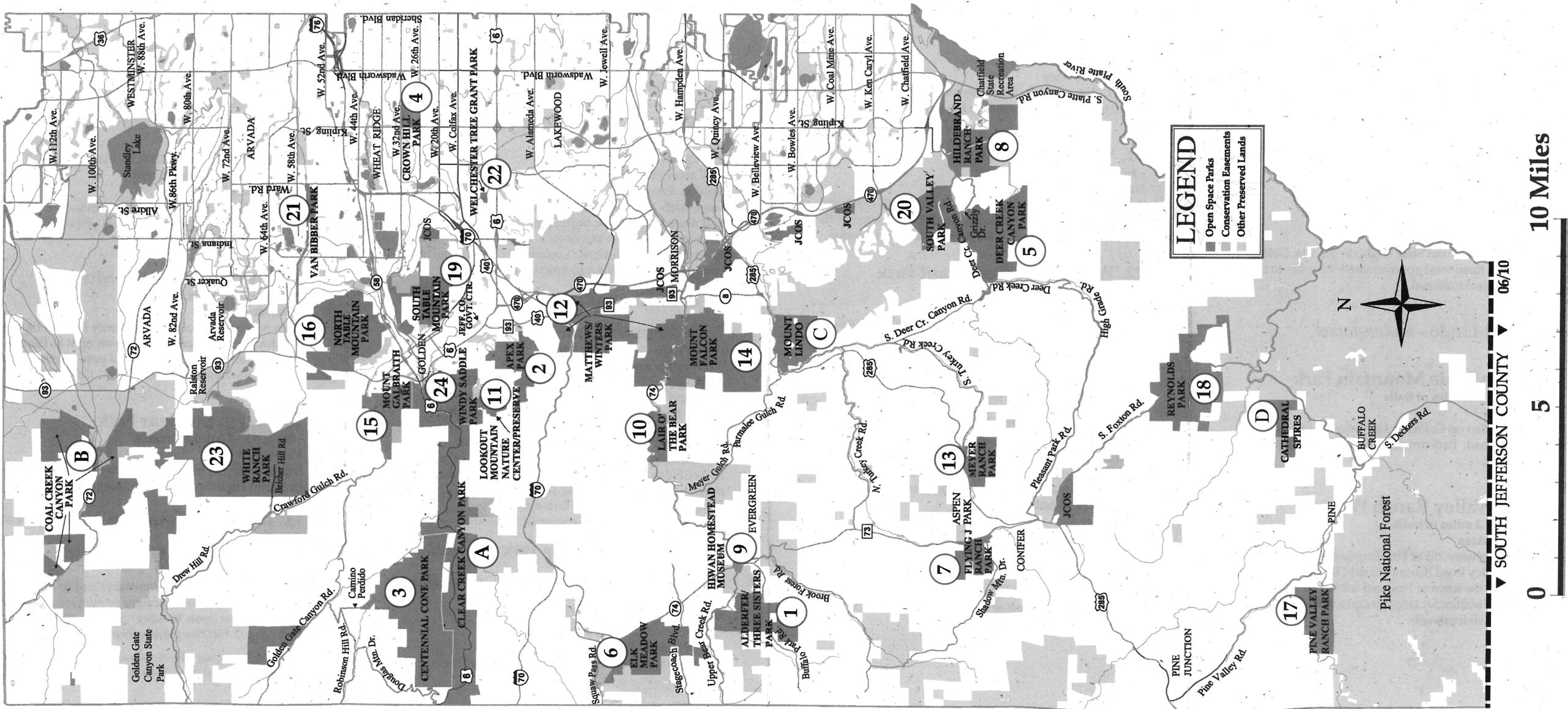

12. Matthews/Winters Park

- 2,257 acres - 8.5 miles of trails

Golden Area

Users segregated at trailhead. Parking area lies just south of I-70 (Morrison exit) interchange on County Highway 93, near the hogback cut.

13. Meyer Ranch Park

- 586 acres - 4.3 miles of trails

Conifer Area

One mile east of Aspen Park, adjacent to U.S. Highway 285, off South Turkey Creek Road.

14. Mount Falcon Park

- 2,330 acres - 11.1 miles of trails

Morrison Area

West access: Take the Indian Hills turn off from U.S. Highway 285; follow Parmalee Gulch Road for 5 miles to Picutis Road; then follow the signs to the parking area. East access: From Colorado Highway 8, south of Morrison, turn west on Forest Avenue and north on Vine Avenue.

15. Mount Galbraith Park

- 813 acres - 4.7 miles of trails

Golden Area

Hiker Only Park. From State Highway 93, take Golden Gate Canyon Road west approximately 1.5 miles to the parking area and trailhead.

C. Mount Lindo - undeveloped

16. North Table Mountain Park

- 1,969 acres - 5.2 miles of trails

Golden Area

North of Golden on Colorado Highway 93, just north of Pine Ridge Road. Park development/trail construction is being phased.

17. Pine Valley Ranch Park

- 884 acres - 5.2 miles of trails

South Jeffco Area

From U.S. Highway 285 at Pine Junction, turn southeast onto Pine Valley Road (County Road 126). Continue 5.8 miles toward the town of Pine and follow the signs to the Park. Facilities for large groups available by reservation; call for details.

18. Reynolds Park

- 1,984 acres - 5.9 miles of trails

South Jeffco Area

Hiker and equestrian only. From U.S. Highway 285 and Foxton Road, drive southeast 5.5 miles to the Park. Over-night camping by permit only; call for details.

19. South Table Mountain Park

- 1,475 acres - 3.3 miles of trails

Golden Area

South access: From South Golden Road enter Pleasant View Community Park at Camp George West on Kilmer Street. East access: Walk-in access from Old Quarry Road.

20. South Valley Park

- 995 acres - 6.9 miles of trails

South Jeffco Area

From C-470, take Ken Caryl Avenue west to South Valley Road; turn left and go south to the main parking area.

21. Van Bibber Park

- 165 acres - 3.8 miles of trails

Arvada Area

A large parking lot is located just south of 56th Drive, on the west side of Ward Road. A small lot is located at the west end of the Park at Indiana Street and 56th Avenue.

22. Welchester Tree Grant Park

- 20 acres - 0.2 mile of trail

Lakewood Area

Parking along West 8th Avenue, from Yank Street to Zang Street.

23. White Ranch Park

- 5,673 acres - 19.1 miles of trails

North Jeffco Area

East access: Travel north of Golden on Colorado Highway 93. Turn left at 56th Avenue and Pine Ridge Road. West access: Take Golden Gate Canyon Road to Crawford Gulch Road; go north 5 miles to Belcher Hill Road and then east for 2 miles. Overnight camping by permit only; call for details.

24. Windy Saddle Park

- 883 acres - 6.0 miles of trails

Golden Area

Small parking area at trailhead along Lookout Mountain Road/Lariat Loop, west of Golden. Connects to Denver's Beaver Brook Trail.

1. Alderfer/Three Sisters Park

- 1,130 acres - 15.5 miles of trails

Evergreen Area

From State Highway 74 take County Highway 73 south to Buffalo Park Road and go west 1 mile to the east parking lot. Continue for .5 mile to the west parking area.

2. Apex Park

- 697 acres - 8.4 miles of trails

Golden Area

Some trails have restrictions; please see kiosk.

East access: is from the northeastern corner of the Heritage Square parking lot (U.S. Highway 40 at County Road 93). West access: via Lookout Mountain Trail from parking area at Lookout Mountain Nature Center.

D. Cathedral Spires - undeveloped

3. Centennial Cone Park

- 3,279 acres - 16 miles of trails

West Jeffco Area

Alternating trail use on weekends with hiking on odd dates and biking on even dates. North access: Highway 93 north from Golden about 1 mile to Golden Gate Canyon Road. Travel west about 8 miles to Robinson Hill Road, turn left and continue to Camino Perdido. Equestrian parking is at north access only. West access: from Golden, travel west on U.S. Highway 6 about 11 miles, turn right at Highway 119 and travel .5 mile to Douglas Mountain Drive. Turn right and go approximately 1 mile to Centennial Cone Road.

4. Crown Hill Park

- 242 acres - 10.5 miles of trails

Lakewood/Wheat Ridge Area

Parking lot on West 26th Avenue at Garrison Street.

5. Deer Creek Canyon Park

- 1,630 acres - 12.8 miles of trails

South Jeffco Area

From C-470 exit Kipling southbound. Turn right on W. Ute Avenue, then right on Deer Creek Canyon Road. Turn left on Grizzly Drive, then right into the Park.

6. Elk Meadow Park

- 1,655 acres - 13.1 miles of trails

Evergreen Area

East access: Parking area lies west of Colorado Highway 74 at Lewis Ridge Road. South access: 1.25 miles west on Stagecoach Boulevard. Dog Off-leash Area south of Stagecoach Boulevard.

7. Flying J Ranch Park

- 420 acres - 4.3 miles of trails

Conifer Area

From U.S. Highway 285, take County Highway 73 north for approximately 1.3 miles to the Park trailhead.

8. Hildebrand Ranch Park

- 1,493 acres - 3.7 miles of trail

South Jeffco Area

From C-470 and Wadsworth, go south to Deer Creek Canyon Road and turn right (west). Travel 1 mile to parking lot on south side of road.

9. Hiwan Homestead Museum

- 4 acres - .25 mile of trail

Evergreen Area

From westbound Colorado Highway 74, turn right onto Meadow Drive. Museum will be on right at Timbervale Drive. Hours: Tuesday-Sunday, 12 p.m. - 5 p.m.; Summer hours: June -August 11 a.m. - 5 p.m. Call 720-497-7650.

10. Lair o' the Bear Park

- 392 acres - 3.3 miles of trails

Morrison Area

Located halfway between Kittredge and Idledale on Colorado Highway 74 west of Morrison.

11. Lookout Mountain Nature Center
& Preserve

- 134 acres - 1.4 miles of trails

Golden Area

From I-70 take Lookout Mountain Road (exit 256), turn right then follow the signs to 910 Colorow Road. Nature Center open Tuesday - Sunday, 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. Call 720-497-7600 for more information.
