What's new with Cactus Jacks Saloon & Grill?

Q: What's new with Cactus Jacks Saloon & Grill?

On March 17, 2020 The Governor of Colorado mandated restaurants to close to sit down service. Usually this day is filled with green beer, corned beef & cabbage and "Kiss Me I'm Irish" intentions, but not today. It was unclear if this would be a week or several months. I was in Florida dealing with the death of my mother, Happy Leap Year everyone. She passed on Feb. 29 and that was the beginning of our personal and professional chaos. Gary headed back to Evergreen where he began a swift effort to save our business. Our business is based on continuous sales. We had to figure out how to make it safe, period!

I watched from a far as Gary instituted take out services. We offered curbside pickup and delivery for the most compromised. Evergreen, Colorado loves a challenge and it was clear how much our community loves us. We were having numbers very comparable to when we were open normally. We were able to retain ALL our staff with the exception of one employee, which was her decision to fully guarantine.

We were given the green light to operate in the "new normal" in early May. In order to ensure our patrons safety we had to get to work. Here are some of the things we implemented to ensure the safety of our employees and patrons. When hand sanitizer was in short supply, we ordered grain alcohol from our vodka distributors and made our own. We are still using it to this day. We donated some to the EAPL for them to raise money. We installed an air filter that catches water droplets from the air. It stands 6'6" tall and sticks out like a sore thumb. We have masks for sale with our logo on them and we provide masks for individuals who have forgotten their mask. We seat each table 8 feet apart & no parties bigger than 8 people. We added additional creekside seating in our parking lot with a covered tent. Our variance recently got expedited and approved by the Jefferson County Planning and Zoning with the help of Betsy Hays and the Chamber of Commerce. We are doing the everyday stuff like cleaning the bathrooms and community surfaces, washing our hands constantly and doing temperature checks of our employees.

We are working with Wilmot Elementary School to raise money to buy a similar tent to use at their facility. We want to educate our kids outside while the weather is still nice. We wanted to pass on our knowledge from working all summer in the "new norm" to our local schools. Please visit our website @ evergreenlivemusic.com for more information.



Q: What's new to your business?

Well, clearly, we have had to adjust and pivot our focuses during the Covid crisis. We are currently operating two "pop up restaurants" which feature some never before offered food options and define us more as a "restaurant", while some of the "entertainment" portions of our facility must remain closed. This past week we merged some of The Wild Games' core menu items with our pop- up menu, all part of a plan to slowly transition back to our previous offerings- with a few changes of course. While we still can't offer the arcade (state mandated closure) we CAN finally offer bowling again! We have been waiting to show Evergreen our brand-new lighting system over our bowling lanes- and so far, the feedback been amazing! Additionally, we now have over 6,000 square feet of outdoor dining, live outdoor music, an outdoor TV, a drive-in movie/sports theatre and we just added a new TV platform that allows us to show Altitude Sports with no blackouts!

Q: Why are these new aspects important to your business?

It was vital to shift the focus to our FOOD, because it was all that we could offer (all that was "legal" to offer) during the first 4 months of the crisis. Once restrictions were loosened- it was extremely important to quickly find a way to safely re-open the bowling alley and grasp an understanding of what we COULD and COULDN'T offer our guests. Once we knew that we could keep our staff and guests SAFE- then came the addition of drive in movie nights, live music and return to hosting events. These new additions have really made the place feel "alive" again, but more importantly help us survive.

Q: Does your business use social media?

YES- and during these hard times it has been a blessing. With sales down, events cancelled and areas of the building mandated closed- spending money on our normal advertising platforms was off the table. Social Media is almost 100% how we have been updating our guests with the changes to our menu, hours of operation, daily specials, etc. Please follow us on Facebook @ The Wild Game- Evergreen.
