- **Monterey County Health Officer Rescinds Short-Term Lodging Order**

On June 11 (last Thursday), 2020, the Monterey County Health Officer issued a statement that included this: In light of release of new [State guidance for Hotels, Lodging and Short-Term Rentals for tourism and individual travel](#) and approval by the County Health Officer for short-term rentals to reopen following the new State guidance, the County Health Officer Short-Term Lodging Order is no longer necessary. All other Monterey County Health Officer Orders remain in effect.
