Soybean producers with SCN concerns are encouraged to submit soil samples for soybean cyst nematode (SCN) egg counts to the SCN Diagnostics clinic in Columbia this spring for free. Missouri Soybean Merchandising Council partnered with the clinic to offer **4 free sample tests** to each producer. All farmers are welcome to submit regardless of county.

*For sampling instructions- <https://scndiagnostics.com/>. Samples should be taken before soybeans are planted (for pre-season numbers). Post-Season samples can be submitted in November. Samples need to be taken fresh or kept refrigerated (do not allow them to dry out).
