we'll gather at Clearwater Country Club at 11 am and meet a specialneeds teacher from Lighthouse of Pinellas.




Danielle (Dani) Johnson will tell us about the various Lighthouse of Pinellas classes and programs to help the blind and sight-impaired lead happy and productive lives.

Scholarship for Future Florida Teachers

Florida Retired Educators Foundation

Since 1980, FREF has awarded scholarships for high school graduates who wish to teach in the State of Florida. The amount is \$4000 over a four-year period, \$1000 per year.

Eligibility Criteria

- ⇒ Seniors graduating from an accredited Florida high school (public/private)
- ⇒ Unweighted GPA of 3.0 or higher
- ⇒ Minimum test scores -SAT 1000 or ACT 22
- ⇒ MUST attend an accredited Florida college/university (public/private)
- ⇒MUST teach in Florida, following graduation. A copy of the OFFICIAL FLORIDA PROFESSIONAL TEACHING CERTIFICATE must be sent to the State FREA Office. The scholarship requires recipients to teach in the State of Florida for one year for every year the scholarship was awarded. If not, they must repay any scholarship monies received.

Application Process

Deadline: January 20, 2024 for application. Other supporting documents must be in by January 31, 2024.

Apply Online: www.frea.org/scholarships. If you do not have a computer, see your Guidance Counselor or the College & College Advisor.

Note: An additional \$500 one-year scholarship may be awarded by North Pinellas County Retired Teachers Association if an applicant is approved for an FREF scholarship in 2024.


