If you are not sure if you have renewed your membership, please check with Paula Walker or Carol Huber.

**SPCREA** will send you a reminder to renew your dues, but the form is also in this **SPCREA** newsletter and on the attendance table at each meeting. Reminders may be sent via email to members receiving newsletters in that format.

**FREA** may send a reminder for your state dues, not local unit dues. If you mail a check to the state, you are current with **state dues only**, unless you include the \$10 extra for your local unit dues. If you send both state and local unit dues to **FREA**, we are unable to verify your local dues until the state sends the check to **Paula**. I encourage you to renew state & local through us to *simplify* matters.

<u>A better solution is to send your dues renewal to Paula directly</u>. Fill out the membership form in the newsletter or on the table at the meetings. You can also use the form to update your address, phone, or email. Give or send the form and money to Paula. Both state and local unit dues are only \$45. Paula will designate both local and state dues are paid, send that information to me, and send your state dues to FREA. I will then update your status to current.

<u>You might consider setting up on auto pay directly from your bank to Paula</u>. It's not difficult, and I have done it for several years. Using your bank's bill payer section, set up an annual payment to **Paula Walker** on a specific date. A check will then be sent to Paula for whatever amount you designate. You will still need to contact Paula or me with any updates (email, address, etc.) however. This is an easy way to pay your dues and stay current without wondering about your status.
