Frequently Asked Questions

Parking: Valet—\$30.00 per day. Self Parking—Free Property map is on back pages of this registration packet.

- 1. I am Self-Parking, how do I get my luggage to my room? Pull into the front of the hotel under the portico. Offload your belongings with the bellman. Go to Self-Parking Lot and park. There is a van on constant rotation that will take you back to the front of the hotel to check-in, claim your belongings, and then a driver and golf cart will deliver you to your room and carry your bags in.
- 2. There are parking lots much closer. What are those? Those are Valet 1 day parking.
- 3. When can I Check-In? Check in is at 4:00 PM. If you are arriving on Tuesday, the General Session starts at 1:00 PM and you may have to wait until after Opening Session to check in.
- 4. Where is Convention Registration? FREA is in the Pegasus Conference area of Saddlebrook. The Registration Desk is in the Pegasus Foyer, down the ramp/stairs to the left as you enter the main hotel foyer.
- 5. Where would I go to bring in Baskets or gift cards for the FREF donations? Pegasus South is the room designated as the Gathering Room this year. There is an outside entrance to the Pegasus Foyer on the side of the main circular drive.
- 6. Where do I take my ALL ABOUT UnitS display? To the Gathering Room in Pegasus South.
- 6. We have no green screen photographer this year, correct? Correct, but we have a roaming photographer and on Wednesday night will have a dedicated photographer and assistant to handle group photos in front of our 70th Anniversary backdrop. You will be able to sign up at Convention with your group for photos. Other times we will have photo backgrounds and areas to cover the different themes and of course there is also the beautiful Saddlebrook property.
- 7. Are we doing 'Theme' Nights? Yes Tuesday night think Tropical Chic, parrots welcome. Wednesday Night think Glamor and Glitz Gala in Platinum and Black.
- 8. Are there restaurants on the property? Yes there are: Tropics serves breakfast, Dempsey's Too serves Lunch and Dinner in the main building, and the Poolside Café serves lunch.
- 9. Is WIFI free? Yes, in both the guest rooms and public areas .
- 10. May I go fishing in the lakes? Yes, equipment is available at the pool kiosk along with pool floats and games. Caution, gators are in most lakes in Florida.
- 11. May I use the Fitness Center? Yes.
- 12. May I bring outside food into my room? Saddlebrook allows snacks and beverages to be brought in to the guest rooms. No parties with outside food supplied are allowed. No deliveries by food delivery service or pizza, etc. is allowed.

- FREA pays TWO nights (\$179.00 per night max.) for FREA Board members. Board members must attend a minimum of 3 nights, and are responsible for the minimum room cost of \$179.00.
- FREF pays TWO nights (\$179.00 per night max.)
 for FREF Trustees—3 nights for those travelling
 from District 1 due to 12 noon FREF meeting time
 on Monday. Trustees must attend a minimum of 3
 nights, and are responsible for the minimum room
 cost of \$179.00.
- We are sorry, but there will be NO Online Registration this year.





- 1. Add up total price of room in the room size chosen.
- 2. Add up all the \$179.00 per night discounts that FREA will pay for. (See previous page and use the Accommodation Worksheets on next 2 pages to organize information)
- 3. Subtract discount amount from total price of the room nights.
- 4. Divide total by # people in condo.
- 5. Total is price per person for the length of stay.
