	Collection Protection Act (Act). This Act prevents collection from indigent patients. SB71 requires health care facilities to screen patients for assistance eligibility and to provide price and payment information. Prohibits discriminatory pricing. Requires health care facilities to report how indigent care funds are spent. Limits enforceability of certain judgments and makes violations of the Patients' Debt Collection Protection Act and the Collection Agency Regulatory Act unfair or deceptive trade practices. SB71 adds to the definition of "collection agency" in the Collection Agency Regulatory Act. Increases surety bond coverage requirements and removes attorney fees and costs for certain suits by collection agencies. Amends and enacts sections of the NMSA 1978.
