SITE VISIT CHECKLIST

- Pre Survey Assessment for Administrator and Infection Control designee to complete 1-2 weeks before scheduled site visit
- Administrator completes Demographic information questionnaire and submits to ICCNM electronically one week before site visit. If you have key areas that you would like to focus on, please let ICCNM know in order to schedule adequate time in that area during the site visit.
- Ensure key staff are present the day of site visit.
- The following individuals should be present at some point during the site visit:
 - Administrator
 - Director of Nursing
 - Infection Control
 - Housekeeping
 - Supervisor
 - Dietary Supervisor
 - Maintenance
 - Supply Chain Staff
- Minimally Administrator, Director of Nursing and Infection Control should attend the interview.
- Key staff should attend the Assessment Summary Exit Meeting
