Hospital Admissions Example

- I have 3 Residents (Sue, Mary, and Dave) went to the hospital in October and were in the AL on the 10/31.
- October Hospital Admissions Numerator (Sue, Mary, Dave = 3) DIVIDED
 by: Denominator (Sue, Mary, Dave plus all the rest of your residents in your AL on 10/31)
- I have 100 total residents on 10/31, this includes Sue, Mary and Dave so I would put 100 in residents on the last day of the month for October and 3 for hospital admissions in my upload sheet
- Note: The residents in your numerator (those sent to the hospital for admission or observation) have to also be in your denominator (those residents in your AL on the last day of the month).
