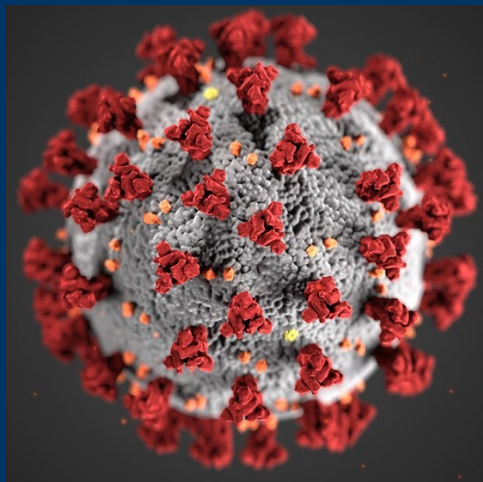
Erie County Chamber of Commerce Golf League

Governor DeWine Orders Ohio Bars & Restaurants to Close

(COLUMBUS, Ohio)— Ohio Governor Mike DeWine announced that the Ohio Department of Health (ODH) has issued a Director's Order that will close all Ohio bars and restaurants to in-house patrons, effective at 9:00 p.m. today, March 15, 2020. Restaurants with take-out and delivery options will still be able to operate those services, even as their dining rooms are temporarily closed.
