



SANDUSKY DORA APPROVED BY CITY COMMISSION

City commissioners passed legislation on Monday, June 14, 2021 approving Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area (DORA) for downtown Sandusky. Patrons of downtown restaurants and bars will be able to walk the streets and exit businesses with drink in hand.

In Sandusky, the downtown DORA generally lines up with the business zoning district and existing community entertainment district boundaries. The area encompasses Decatur to Franklin streets; Washington Park to Sandusky Bay, which would encompass the Jackson Street Pier, the Paper District Marina and the Sandusky Yacht Club.



The City of Sandusky will be working with downtown merchants over the coming weeks to make sure everyone who wants to participate in the DORA will fully understand the rules and how it works. All liquor-serving establishments will be receiving a new liquor permit with a DORA designation, which allows participation in the DORA. However, it is up to each individual business whether or not they want to participate. As for non-liquor establishments, you will be able to make the choice on whether or not you want to permit people with DORA beverages into your establishments.

There are about 60 designated outdoor refreshment area districts operating in cities across Ohio, including in Port Clinton, Norwalk and Fremont. All other alcohol-related laws still apply in a designated outdoor refreshment area, such as those relating to disorderly conduct and underage drinking.


