EMERGING THREAT: XYLAZINE + FENTANYL INCREASES RISK AND HARM

"Xylazine is making the deadliest drug threat our country has ever faced, fentanyl, even deadlier. DEA has seized xylazine and fentanyl mixtures in 48 of 50 States. In 2022, approximately 23% of fentanyl powder and 7% of fentanyl pills seized by the DEA contained xylazine."

Xylazine: The Threat

On April 23, 2023, the White House declared xylazine an emerging threat to the national security of the United States.

Xylazine is a powerful veterinary sedative/anesthetic with no known uses for humans. Since 2019, the DEA reports an increasing presence of xylazine in opioids, stimulants, and opioid-stimulant combinations. If you have a patient with substance use disorder, please consider one of our medically monitored detoxification programs to ensure their safety as they work toward recovery.

Xylazine: The Statistics

The DEA reports that between 2020 and 2021:

- Xylazine-associated overdose fatalities increased by 1127% in the South, 750% in the West, 516% in the Midwest, and 103% in the Northeast
- Xylazine presence in illicit drugs increased by 193% in the South, 112% in the West, 61% in the Northeast, and 7% in the Midwest.
- Xylazine was identified most often in polydrug mixtures containing fentanyl
- DEA officials say the spread of xylazine mirrors the spread of fentanyl in the mid-2010s.
 It began in the Northeast, then spread gradually through the South, Midwest, and Western regions of the U.S.

Xylazine: The Complications

When combined with other drugs, xylazine increases their potency, duration of action, and risk of fatal overdose. However, since xylazine is not an opioid, Narcan cannot reverse a xylazine overdose, and medications for opioid use disorder (MOUDs) do not mitigate xylazine withdrawal.

Evidence shows Xylazine can cause necrotic skin lesions, abscesses, or ulcers that can lead to amputation.

In addition, standard drug tests don't detect xylazine. In many cases, people addicted to xylazine have no idea they've ingested it, which means emergency room personnel and addiction treatment professionals don't know what to look for.

Welcome Home Program July 2023

BELLEVUE, Ohio – Firelands Federal Credit Union, in cooperation with Federal Home Loan Bank (FHLB), is pleased to announce additional funding has been provided for the second round of the 2023 Welcome Home Program (WHP).

The WHP offers grants to fund reasonable down payment and closing costs for low- and moderate-income homebuyers. This year, grants have increased to \$15,000 for homebuyers who are honorably discharged veterans, active duty military personnel, reservists, or surviving spouses of service personnel and \$10,000 for all other homebuyers.

The second round of WHP funds will be available for reservation beginning at 8:00 AM EST on July 6, 2023, and will remain open until all funds have been reserved. Reservations may not be submitted in advance. Funds are offered on a "first come, first-served" basis.
