Subject: **2019 Local Municipal Fall Election Candidate & Voting Guide**





The Metro Housing Coalition (“MHC”) Board of Directors met late last month after the candidate vetting process to decide on contributions and endorsements toward incumbent and prospective candidates within twelve municipalities in this 2019 fall election cycle. The municipalities were chosen based on an annual tiering process and permits/projects based on our membership activities. Candidates may or may not have been participatory in a few municipalities.

Ballots drop 22 days prior to the election. Ballots will be mailed this week with in-person voting beginning the third week of October. The elections will take place on Tuesday, November 5th.






Please note that decisions on supported candidates are done through a complete process coupled with weighted analysis. 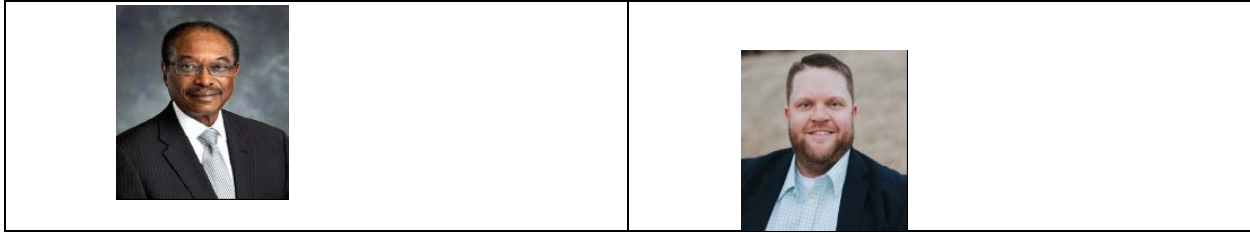
