

The Kittitas County Chamber of Commerce has created a new program called the WISH Fund. The WISH Fund (When Inconvenient Stuff Happens) is a fund dedicated to help small businesses during a time of unexpected difficulty. A Business-to-Business support grant will be awarded to qualified applicants in Kittitas County through the WISH Fund. The businesses or organizations that have experienced loss of funds due to a crisis or disaster may be awarded the Business-to-Business grant to better position themselves for long-term success after this interruption subsides.

Approved applications will enable a business or organization to receive support from the Kittitas County Chamber of Commerce's partnership with the WSU/SBDC agent who can assist with strengthening different aspects of their operations.

The Business-to-Business grants will be paid directly to the service provider by the Kittitas County Chamber of Commerce WISH Fund. The recipients of the grant will be asked to fill out a questionnaire after their services are complete and directed to additional business resources.
