- Third Place, winning \$2,500: Make Music Ellensburg (Kittitas County) A community music school for all ages offering in-person & virtual lessons, classes, workshops, and events.

Winners also receive one-year full subscriptions to LivePlan, a one-year membership to the Greater Yakima Chamber of Commerce, and a one-year membership to the Kittitas County Chamber of Commerce. The top four in the competition also receive complimentary consulting hours from Baker Boyer, this includes The Botany Shop from Kittitas County.
