Lemonade Day Youth Entrepreneurship Program Expands to Kittitas County

ELLENSBURG, WA – April 22, 2022 - The Kittitas County Chamber of Commerce is pleased to announce our newest program, Lemonade Day throughout Kittitas County. Lemonade Day is a national youth entrepreneurship program that teaches leadership and business skills. This is by encouraging children to launch a lemonade business in their community. Open registration for students in grades kindergarten to fifth grade will go live on Monday, June 14, 2022 on our website. The official Lemonade Day event will be on August 20, 2022 happening across Kittitas County. On that day, all participants will be able to showcase their lemonade stand.

A kickoff celebration in Ellensburg is planned for **May 4, 2022 from 5:30 p.m - 7:00 p.m at Top of the 'Burg, Hotel Windrow**. The Cle Elum kickoff celebration will happen on **Tuesday, May 10 from 5:30 p.m - 7:00 p.m located at the Cle Elum Eagles #609 in Cle Elum**.

Mentors guide participants through a variety of entrepreneurship lessons via the My Lemonade Day app or with workbooks and take participants through the journey of planning, launching and operating a business.
