



2023 - 2025 **NEW LAWS!**



The 2023 Legislative Session saw the most consequential changes in residential construction in the last 30 years! In addition to the Statute of Repose (SOR) being lowered to a period of six years when the builder/remodeler provides a one, two and six year written warranty that covers certain elements of the improvements, the Residential Construction Liability Act (RCLA) saw a massive overhaul that is absolutely unprecedented.

- Lowers the structural warranty to six years in order to mirror the lowered SOR;
- Reflects vital Texas Supreme Court decisions regarding arbitration provisions;
- Addresses all-too-common wire fraud in the industry;
- Provides a top-flight sale contingency addendum;
- Includes important pool construction disclosures;
- Updates lot contract provisions;
- Incorporates a revised real estate broker agreement; and
- Provides many other important risk management changes.

As always, the TAB contracts package includes legislatively mandated requirements specific to Texas, the absence of which could result in dire consequences for your business.

Make sure you purchase the contracts package that complies with Texas law!
