WHO SHOULD JOIN?

For-Hire Motor Carrier

A motor carrier hired for compensation, either directly or indirectly, for the transportation service provided.

Private Motor Carrier

Companies that produce, manufacture, and/or supply products that are non-commercial, transportation industry specific, and haul their products via their own fleet of trucks that are leased or owned by the company.

Allied

Companies (non-carriers) that produce, manufacture and/or supply products or services that are commercial transportation specific.

Shipper

A Shipper Member is an entity involved in or responsible for the coordination or procurement of transportation services as the owner or shipper of cargo.

Voice of the Industry

NCTA is the voice of the trucking industry, actively lobbying the North Carolina General Assembly and representing the industry as a voice to federal and state agencies.

Call on Washington

Each year members travel to Washington, DC to meet with elected officials and talk about the issues that are important to the industry.

Your Regulatory Advocate


In addition to the events above, NCTA also provides:

NCTA Safety & Human Resources Council


The Council was created to provide safety and professionalism in the trucking industry. The Safety & Human Resources Council oversees and operates a number of recognition programs that promote highway safety.
