Get to Know Ristretto Coffee Lounge & Wine Bar

The mission of <u>Ristretto Coffee Lounge & Wine</u>
<u>Bar</u> is to build relationships by pouring happiness, says Ristretto's owner Sean O'Leary. It's something they've been doing every day since O'Leary and his wife Colleen bought the café in 2018 from the original owner.

"I feel obligated to preserve this place for the people of Mount Vernon and Skagit County."

O'Leary said their aim with the shop is to keep the focus on local and regional producers, such as baked goods from 5b's and The Scone Lady, beer from Farmstrong and Kulshan breweries, and wines from around Washington state.

Art from local artists fill the walls of the café, and O'Leary said he is proud to support local artists by offering a space to sell their works without taking a commission.

Ristretto pours Victrola Coffee, which hails from the Capitol Hill neighborhood in Seattle, where O'Leary grew up.

He finds the flavor of Victrola's coffee to be like none other: "I can taste the chocolate, hazelnut and berry flavors."

Ristretto, he notes, is a specific espresso extraction method. Meaning "restricted," the output from the beans and the water is less than what is put in, providing a richer, bolder flavor.

Like many businesses, Ristretto endured some lean times during the pandemic. O'Leary said the shop only closed for three days at the very start of the pandemic in March 2020, when they deep cleaned the space and upgraded the HVAC filtration system.

"I felt obligated to my staff to stay open,"
O'Leary said, and he worked to accommodate
employees' comfort level working during the



pandemic. For some employees, that meant they stayed in back of the house roles where they didn't come into direct contact with the customers.

O'Leary also got creative during those months. On Saturdays he would dress up in a Sasquatch costume, waving to potential customers in an effort to drum up business and keep things light during a collectively difficult time.

Now, coming out of the pandemic, he is looking forward to bringing back some of the community-focused events the café used to host, such as Watercolor Wednesdays and open mic Saturdays, which features everything from poetry to music to comedy.

Starting next month, Ristretto will be at the Mount Vernon Farmers Market – a first for the café.

Another first, one of the O'Leary's sons will begin working part-time for the café. "It's nice to start making it more of a family business," he said.
