June we delivered the last session of a very successful 2022-2023 Latino Business Leaders program. We are taking a break in July to get ready to launch the 2023-2024 program in August. Thanks to the support of our generous sponsors and partners, the program was delivered free of charge and welcomed an average of 40-50 participants per session. We outgrew the conference room at the Chamber office and moved to our new location at the Skagit Station. Our presenters did a phenomenal job delivering content that ranged from setting up a business plan, obtaining a business license, working with Labor & Industries and building a marketing strategy.

In partnership with the SCORE Bellingham Chapter, we provided one-on-one business consultations to about 35 start-up businesses. Although most of our Latino entrepreneurs are from Skagit County, it has been very rewarding to see new entrepreneurs coming from Whatcom, Snohomish, King and even Pierce County who have found the program to be valuable and in many cases instrumental in their success.

We have received excellent feedback from our Latino Business Leaders participants, which has allowed the program to continue growing and serving the needs of our community.
