Two examples of the "power of the crowd" were when the government revised the *Canada Emergency Bank Account (CEBA) and the Canada Emergency Commercial Rent Assistance (CECRA)* after receiving feedback from the Network. Tools such as the *BC Mindreader Platform* allowed us to reach across the Province or the country if needed with a simple click of the mouse.

Locally, the Mission Chamber team worked with the District of Mission and Community Futures North Fraser to offer a series of free workshops and seminars. One of the most popular events was the weekly *"Virtual Coffee"* sessions that featured representatives from Work BC, CRA, and Service Canada as well as our MP, both MLA's and the Mayor. These will be revised early in 2021.

We are now ready to meet the challenges of 2021, and we are here to support your business in any way we can. As members of the Chamber, you enjoy many advantages, including discounted rates on events, access to the network at large, as well as the long list of member benefits, however, we work on behalf of all local businesses. Member or not, we are supporting your business.


