Since 1983, Arnold's Shoe Repair has been a staple of downtown Mission, and owner Arnold Atsma is a constant and friendly presence in the shoe repair shop.

On February 18 at the Clarke Theatre, Atsma was recognized with the Customer Service Excellence Award at the 2021 Business Excellence Awards.

"I've really appreciated Mission and all they have done for me. I've had a wonderful time serving them," he said.

"I'm just here by myself every day," he said. "I'd like to get out and do a little more travelling—finally look at BC as a whole and not just a quarter of it."
