Unemployment Information

What I know today:

- Federal extension of claims (CARES Act) through March 14, 2021 with qualified claimant benefits fully phasing out by April 5, 2021. This includes Federal Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA) and Pandemic Emergency Compensation Unemployment Compensation (PEUC)
- Federal Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (FPUC) benefits resumed with \$300 weekly payments until March 14, 2021.
- No solid information on new stimulus but extensions of benefits expected.
- As of January 18, 2021 partial unemployment will be based on hours worked not days. A person may work 30 hours or less or earn gross pay of \$504 or less per week and still receive some unemployment benefits.
