
## Prior Lake Bathroom


## Summary

The original 1999 bathroom no longer functioned for the homeowners in this phase of life. In addition to outdated and failing materials, the existing floorplan was boxy and didn't use space efficiently. The shower was expanded to include a steam shower and bench, the change to a freestanding tub allowed for improved traffic flow. 
## **Existing Floorplan**








Wall mounted faucets offer a clean and open vanity surface with his and hers sinks.


