



Minnetonka Kitchen Remodel




New features like the new giant kitchen island, large wet bar area, custom cabinetry and pantry made for an epic transformation!


Primary Goals:

BEFORE & AFTER FLOOR PLANS











Dated tile flooring, dated and bland cabinetry, odd diagonal kitchen island with sink and zero natural lighting in this kitchen corner provided a space in dire need of a remodel. Moving the island to the center of the floor offered more room to expand the kitchen area along the wall. The sink was moved over to the countertop and a window was added directly above it to provide some much-needed natural light to the area. All new appliances, cabinetry and hardware were added with highlights of custom woodwork and shelving throughout. Removing the carpet and tile and the adding new hardwood flooring to the whole space enhances the look and feel of the kitchen.





In this area we were able to convert a makeshift office area and small closet space into a lovely wet bar area with plenty of additional storage. The dark paint selections on the cabinetry really make the gold hardware standout along with adding to the eye appeal of the wood shelving. All new vibrant white quartz countertops throughout the kitchen give the kitchen a fresh new feel and help to tie this very large space together.





Utilizing some limited extra space, we were able to convert this computer/office nook into a new and much-needed pantry space.

With all the new, brightly painted walls and cabinetry, this once dark, dated and cramped space is now light and spacious. The highlights of woodwork on the hood, shelving and ceiling beams add to the comfy feel of this new kitchen.

Lastly, if you peek in the bottom right corner, there is a custom built-in cubby for the dog to enjoy a bite or lap up some water.
