

- Working around existing elements that could not be changed while them feeling intentional


BEFORE FLOOR PLAN






SHOWER/TUB ELEVATION (E2)

The chimney / flue was removed and replaced with high-efficiency equipment to free up valuable floor space. Interior walls were removed at the linen closet, toilet, and front entry closet which allowed for a clean slate for space planning purposes.

The existing round window was balanced with round mirrors and a round light over the tub, making it feel like an integral part of the overall design.

The fresh finishes and continued use of clean lines and patterns throughout the space at the walls, floors, and cabinetry graining added interest by achieving a layered, welcoming, spa-like environment.

A new transom window was added above the new vanity and the existing transom was shortened to have matching horizontal lines with each other while providing more natural light.
