Located in Minneapolis, the condo underwent a thoughtfully designed and executed makeover, getting the home ready for the next phase of their lives. The owners initially contacted our organization with the objectives of increasing natural light, improving the flow of their home, adding work spaces countertop space and improving storage capacity.

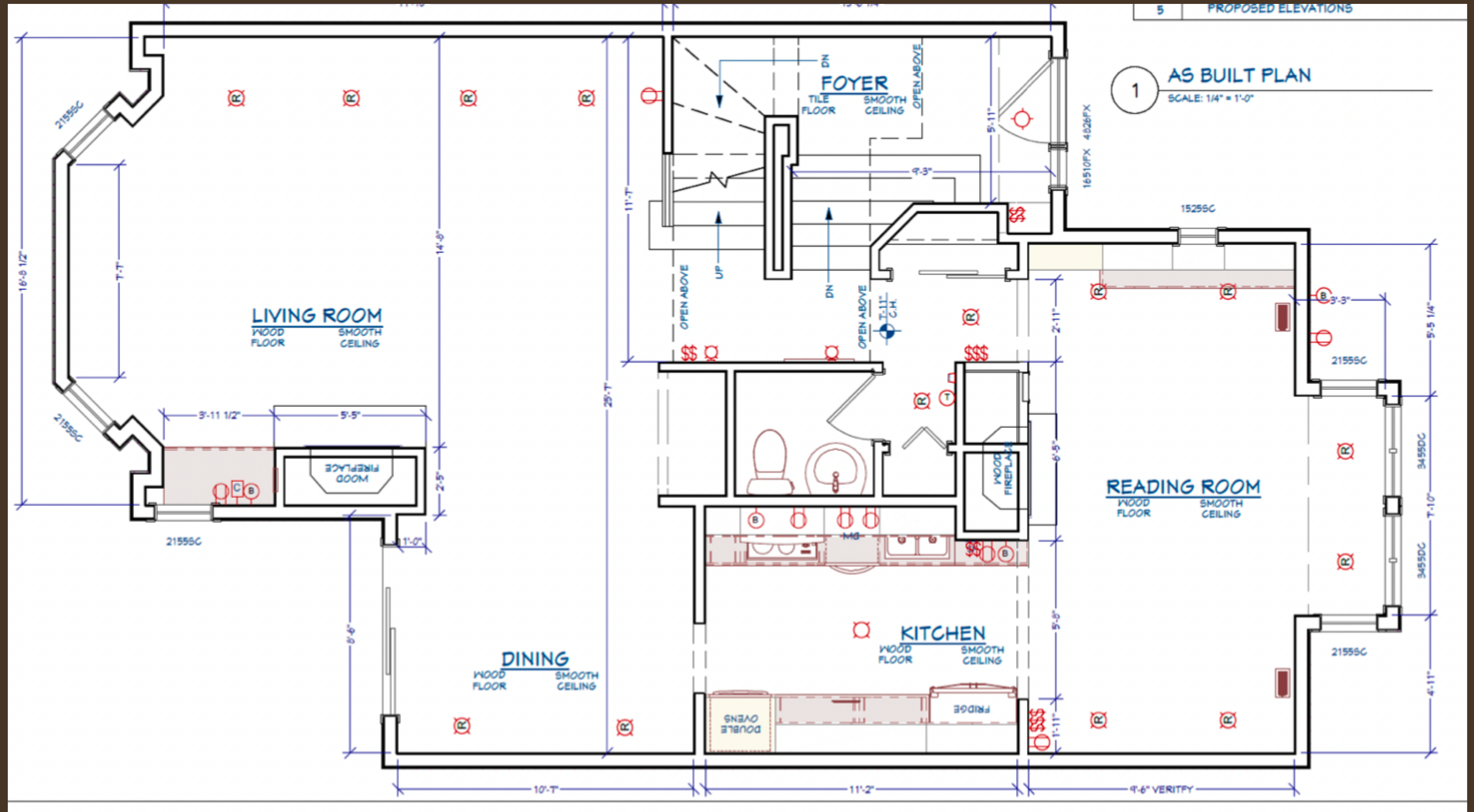

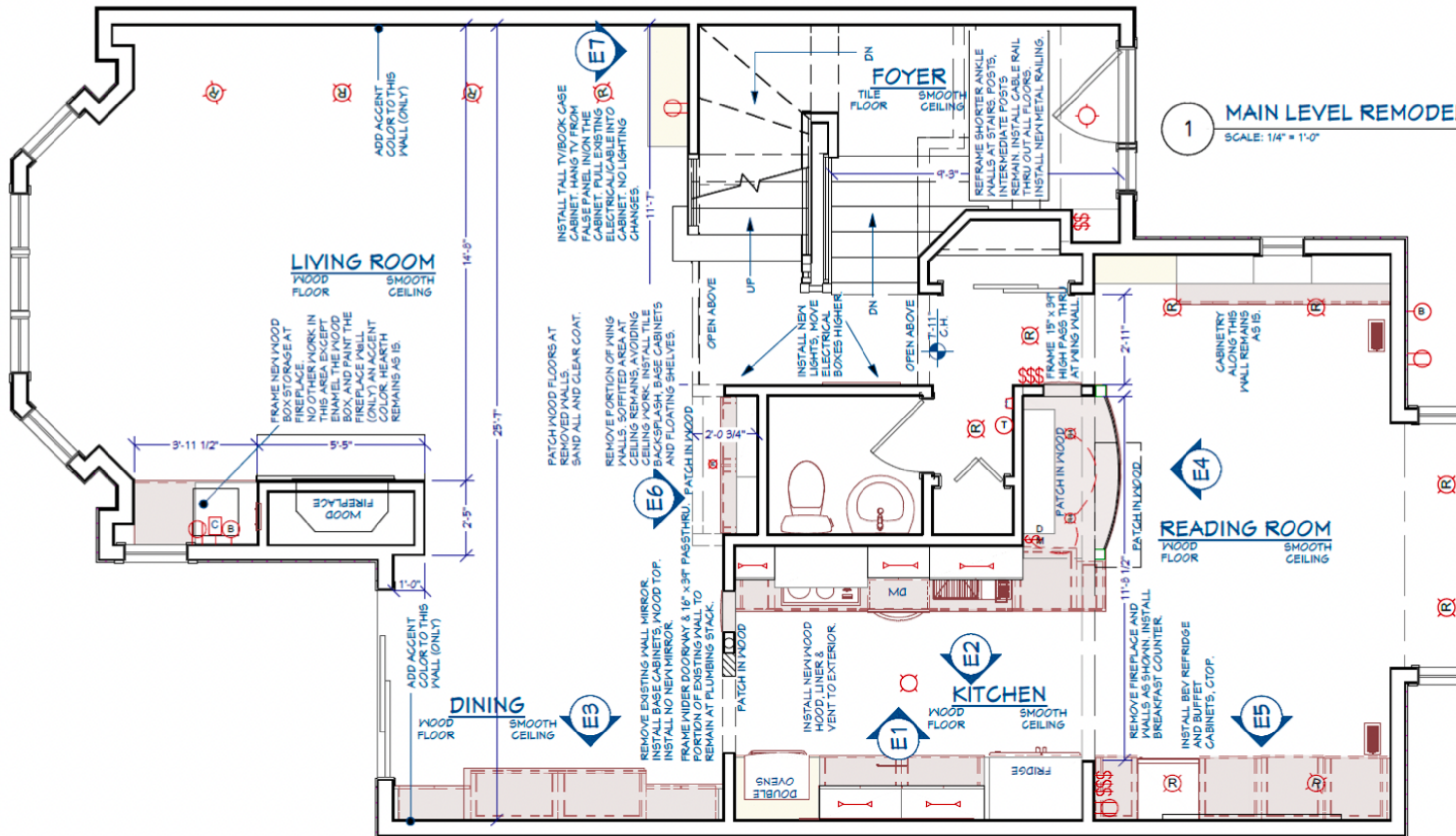
