


#### THE PROJECT











## **BEFORE FLOOR PLAN**

### FUNCTIONALITY

- Moved fridge location so space would feel more spacious when people are seated at the island
- Add a beverage bar so drinks can be easily reached outside of the primary kitchen work zone
- Move microwave to the inside of the island allow for large pantry storage
- Stone perimeter countertops and a butcher block island.
- Full height backsplash around window and above range reflect more light
- New layout of dimmable recessed lights along with new dimmable pendant lights above island.




### AESTHETICS

#### **PROJECT CHALLENGES**

- This project was started right before Covid hit. There were a lot of moving parts on the schedule. From homeowners getting sick to subcontractors needing to shut down for weeks at a time to our team needing to quarantine. By the end of the project, we were all celebrating its completion a little more than normal.
- The semi-custom cabinet shop, we ordered our cabinets completely shut down out of the blue with no heads up. We were left weeks out from an installation date with no answers. Luckily our years in the business allowed us to call in a huge favor and have our custom shop produce these cabinets, only delaying this project by four weeks!
