PROJECT OVERVIEW



A bathroom that was almost 22 feet long, included 3 sinks and an expansive whirlpool tub may seem like the epitome of a luxurious owner's suite, but bigger may not always be better. This large bathroom lacked storage, an appropriately sized shower and left the users frustrated with its overall design and oddities.

PROJECT GOALS



- Improve the layout to include a larger shower, a spacious walkin closet, ample storage, and an oversized soaking tub
- Make the space feel like a serene escape from the rest of the home








BATHROOM ELEVATION




BEFORE:

- The existing master bath had dated finishes, plumbing, and cabinetry. The space didn't fit our client's aesthetic.
- An odd feature of the existing master bath was that it could be accessed from both the master bedroom and office.
- The existing master bath had limited storage and the cabinetry was in poor working condition.

AFTER:

- The updated master bath is a relaxing retreat. The space transformed with updated cabinetry, plumbing, and sophisticated finishes.
- By reconfiguring the layout and closing off the entrance from the office, we were able to improve the layout of the bath and increase the size of the existing shower.
- The updated bath includes a built-in makeup vanity with a mirror and storage.



Client Requirement:

Increase shower size

Solution:

 Re-organized the original layout and some of the adjacent rooms to accommodate a sizable shower with a bench




Client Requirement:

Add more storage

Solution:

- Removed 3rd sink to shrink the water closet and add more cabinetry in the main bathroom area
- Re-designed the layout to allow for a large linen cabinet across from the shower area
- Added wall cabinets that came down to the countertop



Client Requirement:

- Enhance tub area

Solution:

- Replaced clunky oversized whirlpool tub with a slender, user friendly undermount tub
- Added walls and beam elements which helped break up the long/linear space
- Added decorative lighting



Client Requirement:

 Enhance user's experience while "getting ready"

• Solution:

- Designed the bathroom layout to include a sit-down make-up vanity
- Added several wall sconces for additional light
- Incorporated taskspecific accessories for storing hot tools and organizing makeup

CHALLENGE / SOLUTION



Challenge:

Reduce noise transfer from bathroom to bedroom

Solution:

- Used a portion of the existing bedroom to create a vestibule into the bathroom
- Added two pocket doors entering into the bathroom from the bedroom
