








BEFORE FLOOR PLAN

FUNCTIONALITY

- Added 17 x 17 functional gym addition without losing space in home
- Installed bath exhaust fan while updating the bath space to fit the client's style, with ceramic tile shower, new vanity and plumbing fixtures
- Replaced ceiling drywall and included an RC channel to avoid future cracking. Replaced all basement trim for a clean finished look
- Oversized screen porch- we shifted porch over 2 feet from previous deck location as well as extended gym addition 2 ft beyond corner of existing home leaving a 4 ft stairway corridor between additions.
- Designed a low sloped roof on the gym addition to avoid any main floor windows. We extended the gym an extra 4 ½ feet with door access on the pool side for built in pool storage








AESTHETICS

- Finished metal under decking to complete lower-level entertainment area









CRAFTSMANSHIP/ INNOVATIVE METHODS & USES

- Black rubber flooring in gym addition
- Floor to ceiling mirrors
- Repurposed existing bedroom window to create egress in gym space
- Added RC Channel in family room ceiling before re-sheet rocking to eliminate future cracking
- Created stair corridor for easy access to both levels of the home and pool area
- Created exterior pool storage area while staying within the neighborhood covenants of no outbuildings





PROJECT CHALLENGES

- Wanted a gym space but no good place to put it
- Issues from a previous basement remodel including no bath exhaust installed, ceiling cracking and poorly installed trim
- Challenges on the outside- we had to lay footing and reroute all pool equipment and pool underground lines, adding the addition while working around existing main floor windows
- Create an oversized screen porch measuring 16 \times 16, avoiding major impact with rear window sight lines
- Work around association rules forbidding outbuildings while still getting needed pool storage
- Limited access to rear yard because of landscaping and existing privacy fence which forced us to pump concrete from the street & manually carry all building materials
