



# Woodside Kitchen

These homeowners wanted a home on Lake Minnetonka. They knew they wanted a remodel rather than new build based on costs. The floor plan of the home was choppy, and the style was outdated but offered the opportunity to create the vision they desired. By finding a home with a good exterior we could focus our efforts on interior updates.

The main goal of this remodel was to optimize the main level by creating an open floor plan. The homeowners enjoy entertaining family and friends, so they wanted a scullery and large kitchen with ample storage and appliances.

To gain the space the homeowner's needed, we removed the wall from the kitchen to the great room, as well as the large, curved stairwell from the front of the house. This allowed us to move the kitchen forward and create a large pantry behind. The new layout ended up making room for an exterior door to a new grill deck!





Other ways we opened up the room were by adding more windows for natural light, selecting lighter, reflective materials, and hanging custom cable lighting throughout the kitchen. These changes provided the homeowners with a breathtaking view of the lake from the kitchen.





Unique features of this project include white oak ceiling beams running through the center of the home and into the kitchen. The island is something to behold at 12 feet and features a layered waterfall of quartz over walnut. These changes create a kitchen that is truly the heart of this home.
